


Alpine town of the year - 13 January 2025



- Inter-municipality grouping 38 municipalities with populations of between 100 and 60,000 inhabitants
- Total population = 142 655 habitants
- 53 000 ha of which:
 - 65% natural areas and forests (including 57% woodland)
 - 26% agricultural land
 - 9% urbanised areas

The Citizens' Climate Club's objectives

Implement concrete actions:

> DO, ACT

>TEST, EXPERIMENT

>TELL, SHOW and perhaps REPLY

To complement the actions of Grand Chambéry
 (water, mobility, housing, forestry, agriculture, etc.),
 associations, municipalities, etc. with the capacity for
 action and the drive of citizens, collective intelligence, etc.



Recruitment of local volunteers

- Pre-focused actions resulting from consultation on the climate plan, communicated at the time of application;
- 125 applications received by September 2022, for 50% of the total number of members.
- Then recruitment every year to make up for the departure of around 50% of the members after one year.

Functioning

- Project teams (between 6 and 9 depending on the year)
- 3 plenary meetings per year, to provide methodological input on project management, facilitate group work, exchange ideas between groups, bring in experts...
- The groups work independently (meetings, encounters, visits, etc.) to advance their projects and call on Grand Chambéry as and when required (budget, logistical assistance, need for contacts, communication, support from elected representatives etc.)

 Grand Chambéry and a service provider keep an eye on the activity of the groups between plenary meetings (What's app channels, mailing, etc.).

What the Club isn't	What the Club is
A local citizens' climate convention	Teams of residents to carry out targeted actions on mobility, energy, renaturation, etc.
A participatory budget	Support from the conurbation:>an annual budget for all actions>an external facilitator to help the teams run and become autonomous>logistical and communication support (rooms, media, etc.)
A body to issue opinions on projects or the climate plan	Team autonomy: project implementation and scope (target, location, etc.), organisation of meetings (frequency, location, agenda, etc.).

The commitment and support of Grand Chambéry

- Allocate an annual budget to the citizens' climate club for the implementation of projects, in terms of investment and running costs
- o Provide the human resources needed to run the plenary sessions and monitor and support the teams (in-house and with the support of an external facilitator)
- Facilitate the work of the Climate Club by putting members in touch with resource players,
 sharing feedback and encouraging dialogue between teams
- Implementing a set of rules for the club, to ensure a common working framework and a shared operating charter
- Rentalise access to a third-party venue to give groups the autonomy they need to meet.
